Sermon Outline

1. As Jesus was healing people He was bringing the Kingdom of God, He was bringing forth restoration, but we need to remember that healing the sick restores the body, but a repentant heart restores the soul.
2. It says in Psalm 25:9 *He guides the humble in what is right and teaches them his way.* What is the connection between humility and being able to be guided or led?

3. *Psalm 149:1 says, “For the LORD takes delight in his people; he crowns the humble with salvation.”* What is the connection between being humble and salvation?

4. *James 4:10 Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will lift you up.* Why does the Lord lift us up when we are humble?

5. The word humble means to bring low, to be under, subjection, of low estate, or a condition of lowly. If we are going to walk out the Christian life we are going to have to humble ourselves before the Lord.
6. How has the Lord humbled you in your life?

7. Blessed means more than happiness; it means singularly favored, graciously approved by God.
8. As salt preserves and brings out the best flavor of good, so believers should affect others positively.
9. What does it mean to be the salt and light of the world? How can you be salt and light where the Lord has planted you?

10. What is the Lord telling you in our message today?
