Main thoughts for today’s message.

1. When I repent of my sin and cry out to the Lord something begins to happen to my deaf ears to the Lord...I begin to hear the Lord’s voice again.
2. The Lord often reminds us of who he is and what he has done for us to call us upward to take our focus off ourselves and to place it on him. When we do this, it changes our entire perspective.
3. Lord when I am weak you are strong.
 - a. *It says in 2 Cor. 12: 9-10 But he said to me, “My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.” Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ’s power may rest on me. ¹⁰ That is why, for Christ’s sake, I delight in weaknesses, in insults, in hardships, in persecutions, in difficulties. For when I am weak, then I am strong.*
4. When you are filled with doubt focus on God’s word.
 - a. *Hebrews 13:6 “Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.”*
